Notes from Barbara Parry re publicity.

After the Herborn trip – formulated press release with input from Carolyn, Don and Mark and Ruth. Opted for a "one-size-for-all" approach even though there was concern that the doc was too long. Circulated on Tuesday 9th June – Alton Post Gazette, Haslemere Messenger, Basingstoke Observer, Basingstoke Gazette, Alton Herald, Surrey-Hants News, Eagle Radio Newsdesk.

Also, circulated to parish council contacts in the locality – for parish magazines who were particularly interested in publicising if there were people from their villages in the choir. I was able to say "yes this was the case" to the Medstead, Four Marks and Holybourne contacts (as these were pickup points and I knew Judy at least lived in Medstead!). I now also have an accurate mailing list of contacts to future parish circulations.

I thought I might ask if choir members would consider being my "parish magazine" contacts if they live in any of these local villages? What do you think?

I've exchanged emails with Wenda Moroney (Chair of Winchester Community Choir) as she sent me the WCC details of Tuesday 7th July's performance (and I think also sent this to Helen?). She's very happy to circulate our performances to WCC members in case they can join the audience. Do we have a similar contact for Peterfield Community Choir by any chance?

- Leaflets to residents and also communal noticeboard posters (re performance in residents' lounge on 16th July 2015) delivered to reception at Orchard House on 18th June 2015.
- A4 posters (re pub performance on 16th July 2015) delivered to The White Hart on 18th June 2015 also.
- Following on from Alton Post Gazette publicity (which included all the text of the press release and both photos with captions!) Pauline Esland from ATTA asked for a copy of the article and photos which I sent to her on 18th June 2015.
- At War's Command publicity: graphics from Liss performance publicity at St Mary's church last year now scanned for future use as jpg files to "drop in" to any future publicity as required.

Helen and I liaised with Haydn and Maria Elliott (ACCentre Manager) and amended and circulated poster drafted by Haydn. (final version attached) I emailed Haydn re Combat Stress and proceeds from the performance...and Haydn's reply circulated to committee.

(I noticed the Combat Stress collection tins at Waverley Abbey House, so they might also be available for the Community Centre event – should we ask Emilia perhaps who to contact to obtain some?)

I've also drafted the programme using text from the Liss performance and including the Combat Stress logo. Copy attached for information – I've sent this through for Haydn/Maria to print for audience who attend on 4th July.
